



Program Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for assistance through the Harmonious Home Program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Residency

- Must reside within El Paso County limits.

2. Age & Household Status

- Individuals 18 years of age or older.
- Families or individuals transitioning out of homelessness, or unstable/transitional housing.
- Young adults (ages 18–24) aging out of the foster care system in need of additional support.
- Priority may be given to young adults aging out of foster care, households with children, seniors, or individuals with disabilities.

3. Income, Financial Stability & Independence

- Proof of income or financial support is required (e.g., recent pay stubs, unemployment documentation, benefit letters).
- Applicants must demonstrate sustainable income or financial support and a plan to continue maintaining independence, such as:
 - a. Ongoing or secured rental assistance for a prolonged duration (6 months minimum), and/or
 - b. Sustainable earned income or benefits sufficient to support long-term housing stability and independent living.

4. Housing Stability & Sustainability

- Applicants must demonstrate **prolonged housing stability** and readiness for long-term housing success.
- Sustainability may be demonstrated through:
 - a. Participation in prolonged interventions and/or wraparound support services,

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- b. Active engagement with case management or supportive service providers, and
- c. Evidence of stable housing arrangements (e.g., signed lease, housing voucher, or verified long-term rental assistance).

5. Referral & Verification

- Applicants must be referred by a partner agency, caseworker, or educational institution liaison.
- All information provided by the applicant must be verified with the referring caseworker or agency.

6. Required Documentation

- Valid photo ID for the individual applicant or head of household (must be 18 years of age or older).
- Proof of El Paso County residency (lease, utility bill, or shelter verification).
- Proof of income, benefits, or financial support.
- Referral and verification from a recognized community partner or caseworker

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
